

Chieti



According to mythological legends, the city was founded in 1181 B.C. by the Homeric Greek hero Achilles and was named in honor of his mother, Thetis.

Chieti is situated a few kilometers away from **the Adriatic Sea**, and with **the Majella and Gran Sasso** mountains in the background. It is divided into the old town on the homonymous hill and the more recent commercial and industrial area, which is called **Chieti Scalo** and has developed thanks to the Chieti railway station along the ancient layout of Romans Via Tiburtina. Chieti is amongst the most ancient of Italian cities. It originated as Teate, chief town of the Marrucini (an ancient Italic tribe), and was taken by the Romans in 305 BC. Destroyed by the barbarians and rebuilt by Theodoric the Ostrogoth king in the 6th century, it was successively a Lombard stronghold, a Norman county, and a possession of the Hohenstaufens, the Angevin dynasty (house of Anjou), the house of Aragon, and the Caracciolo. Its ancient name was applied to the religious order of the Theatines, founded in 1524 to combat Lutheranism and to reform morality. Roman monuments include the ruins of a theatre and of three small temples and the octagonal Church of Santa Maria del Tricalle, built on the site of the pagan temple of Diana Trivia.

The 11th-century **cathedral**, frequently rebuilt, has a **Gothic bell tower** (1335–1498). Chieti contains the National Museum of Archaeology, the Institute of Art, a theological university, and a provincial library and picture gallery.





Pescara

Pescara is a relatively **modern city** because the city was originally two small fishing villages, which were merged by the fascist government in 1927. The **river Pescara** that divides the city into North and South as it flows down from the mountains has also shaped the city's history.



The city is attracting an increasing number of visitors who enjoy swimming in the **warm waters of the Adriatic** and finding a tasty seafood lunch down by the harbour in one of the fisherman's huts/restaurants. Others adore picking up some designer names in the city centre, before reclining with a coffee in the elegant **Piazza della Rinascita**. And there are those who can barely wait for the sun to set before hitting the **cocktail bar and the beachside nightclubs**.

The University was established in 1965 as a 'Libera Università' (non state-owned university) and became state-owned in 1982.


Today, it has 13 Departments and 2 Schools.

ARRIVAL BY AIRPLANE



Rome Airports: Whether you land at Fiumicino "Leonardo da Vinci" Airport or Ciampino "G. B. Pastine" Airport, you will need to take a bus to reach Pescara or Chieti.

Abruzzo International Airport: Pescara International Airport of Abruzzo (PSR) is located 3 kilometres from the Pescara city centre.



To get to the city **you can take bus no. 38**, which departs **every 15 minutes**. The bus **leaves from outside the airport terminal to the railway station in Pescara's city centre.** The **trip takes about 10 minutes**, and **tickets are sold in automatic machines in the Arrivals Area**. The buses are run by the company TUA: <u>» Linee Urbano Pescara - TUA SpA</u>.

If you prefer to take a **taxi**, there is a rank outside the airport terminal. The **ride to the city centre takes about 10 minutes**.

ARRIVAL BY TRAIN





Close to the bus station, in the hearth of Pescara, there is the train Station. If you choose to arrive to Pescara by train, <u>here is the link</u> to book the tickets.


